

AGREEMENT ON COOPERATION

BETWEEN

ASSOCIAÇÃO COMERCIAL DE LISBOA

AND

GOA CHAMBER OF COMMERCE & INDUSTRY

With the aim to promote and strengthen economic and commercial relations and cooperation between its members, equally and to their mutual benefit, the Associação Comercial de Lisboa and the Goa Chamber of Commerce & Industry hereinafter "Both Parties", have reached the following agreement:

- 1. Both Parties shall promote, equally and to their mutual benefit, cooperation between business people and economic, commercial and financial institutions of both countries.*
- 2. Both Parties shall, within their competences, exchange systemic and business-related information.*
- 3. Both Parties shall participate actively in finding ways and resources for cooperation and, with mutual assistance, hold events for business people from both countries.*

4. Both Parties shall support and develop cooperation between enterprises and establish links among them, both for the purpose of trade and joint ventures, industrial cooperation, technology transfer and other forms of business cooperation.
5. Both Parties shall hold regular meetings, when necessary, with the aim to analyze results of this Agreement, make decisions relating to new fields of future cooperation and the activity plan, and discuss other issues deriving from the Agreement.
6. The Agreement shall come into effect on the date of its signing, and shall expire three months upon the day when any party to the agreement notifies the other party in writing about its intention to terminate the Agreement.
7. The Agreement is made in English in two (2) identical copies.
